



2021–22 STUDENT MUSICIAN SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The North State Symphony League of Redding is offering scholarship opportunities for northern California music students, to award performance and academic achievement, and to assist in the pursuit of higher education opportunities.

Two \$750 scholarships will be awarded in Spring 2022 to one (1) high school senior, and one (1) college/university student.

Scholarship Information

Application Deadline: March 11, 2022

North State Symphony League Scholarships are open to the following students:

High School

Any senior (12th grade) attending school in the following counties: Del Norte, Humboldt, Trinity, Siskiyou, Shasta, Lassen, Modoc.

Any senior (12th grade) planning to attend, or enrolled in, an institute of higher learning in the Fall of the pertinent season.

College/University

Student must be enrolled in an institute of higher learning located within the performance area of the North State Symphony (generally Butte, Tehama, Shasta counties).

We do not require that the student be a declared music major, but we do request that they be involved with their music department either by participating in private lessons or by participating in an ensemble such as orchestra, band, wind or brass ensemble, choir, string quartet, etc.
